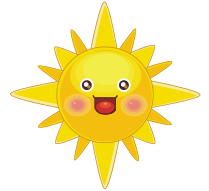

Just to remind you that if your child is away from school for any reason we do need an explanation from you as to why they are absent. If they have a medical appointment, we **MUST** see the letter/appointment card, in order to be able to authorise that absence. Any absences that are not explained or not explained satisfactorily will be unauthorised. If your child has more than eight unauthorised absences (four days) we have to notify the Local Authority and you may receive a Penalty Notice warning letter from them. Holiday can only be authorised in exceptional circumstances.

We are also seeing an increase in lateness. Please ensure your child is in the playground by 08:45am ready to line up with their teacher at 08:50am. Class 5 had 4.17% lateness this week up to Thursday that equates to 6 pupils in 4 days!
